




<p><i>Middle Archaic</i></p> <p>6,000 B.C.E. to 3,000 B.C.E.</p>	<p>Corner notched and stemmed</p> 
<p><i>Late Archaic</i></p> <p>3,000 B.C.E. to 1,000 B.C.E.</p>	<p>Variety</p>
<p><i>Early Woodland</i></p> <p>1,000 B.C.E. to 300 B.C.E.</p>	<p>Straight-stem Square-based contracting</p> 
<p><i>Middle Woodland</i></p> <p>300 B.C.E. to 500 C.E.</p>	<p>Corner-notched</p> 
<p><i>Late Woodland</i></p> <p>500 C.E. to 1620 C.E.</p>	<p>Unnotched Small side notched Corner notched</p>
